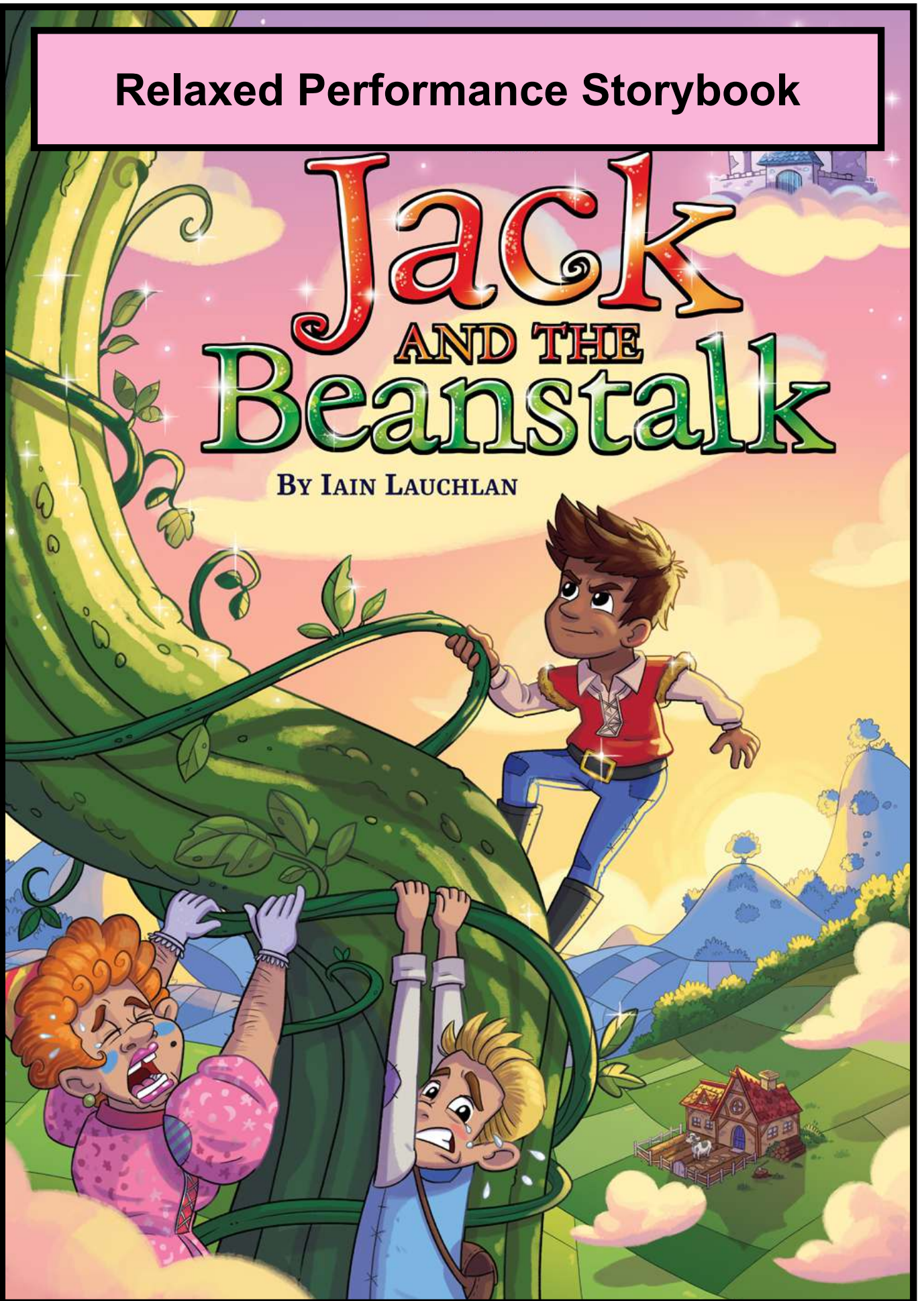

The show Cloth

Scene 4 The Road to Market

Scene 6 The Beanstalk

Scene 7 The Giant's Kitchen
